
UPPER SCHOOL STUDENT DEVICES

The Upper School functions under **BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) policy**. Students must bring their own devices in order to fully participate in educational activities and receive appropriate support. To ensure that, we recommend the below configuration:

Operating System	Mac (10.11 or higher), Windows 8 or higher, Chrome OS
RAM Memory	Minimum of 4GB
Audio/Video	Built-in or external microphone and a built-in webcam - earplugs are recommended but not required
Keyboard	Device keyboard and language must be in English and suited to touch typing
Wireless adapter	802.11 N, AC or above
Required Software	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Browsers: English version of Firefox, Google Chrome or Safari• Antivirus (Free versions such as AVG or Avast! are sufficient) - not necessary for Chromebooks
Other	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• It is important that the student brings the power cord (along with power adapter) and/or extra battery to ensure device is running when necessary.• Students should have sufficient rights to update and install appropriate software

CALCULATOR

To all 8th - 12th Grade students: Students will use **Texas Instruments TI-84 Plus CE Edition calculator** in Math and Science through Upper School and into college.

This calculator is easier to find in the US than in Brazil. Its approximate cost is US\$ 130, and it may be ordered through the web page at **Amazon** or at the Texas Instrument website: bit.ly/earjcalc.
